Advanced technology can make gum disease treatment, teeth straightening, and placement of dental implants faster and easier on the patient.

For example, Dr. Wilson was the first periodontist in Minnesota to use the LANAP® Procedure to treat gum infections that, if left untreated, could lead to tooth loss and potentially serious systemic health problems.

"This laser energy, specifically calibrated for gum tissue, kills bacteria in the pockets that form between the teeth and gums when periodontal disease is present," Dr. Wilson explains. "Healthy tissue is spared and an environment for healing is created." New tissue bonds to the teeth and bone, shrinking the space where infections take root so they are less likely to recur.

"There's no cutting of the gum, so the procedure is much more comfortable than traditional treatments," he adds.

Rapid Orthodontics and Implants



Using a well-established periodontal technique, bone that anchors teeth is softened and treated with a grafting material. "The softening allows traditional orthodontic appliances to move teeth faster, while the graft secures teeth in their new positions," Dr. Wilson says. With Wilckodontics, he can work closely with an orthodontist to design a beautiful new smile in months instead of years. Also at Metropolitan

Periodontists, patients who need dental implants to replace missing teeth in areas close to sinuses and nerves can finish treatment four to six months faster. By using

a shorter implant that requires less bone grafting, this breakthrough procedure takes less time, is costeffective, and patients report less discomfort.
